\*Days must be chosen more than 1 week ahead. Rates are per student.

- **Drop-ins cost \$70/day.** This includes any enrollment made within 1 week of the day enrolled. No discounts will be given.
- Once enrollment has reached its max, no other students may enroll in order to maintain proper social distance. Refunds are not available for unused days. Credit is available with 1 week's notice.

## WHAT TO BRING

### ATTIRE

- **For dancers:** please wear a leotard of any color and convertible tights of any color. SSDA booty shorts are also permitted.
- **For boys and kids participating in other activities:** please wear comfortable clothing, like sweatpants and a tshirt.
- Sneakers and socks are required for everyone. Extra layers are also advised.

- Please pack a healthy snack, lunch, and refillable water bottle for your child. Lunches must be nut-free.
- **Children will need to bring their own devices and device chargers for online learning.** In order to accommodate multiple children learning at once, headphones are also required and must be supplied independently. We will not have additional items so please make sure you pack these items each day.

## WITHDRAWAL

- Due to the limited spacing available for this program, at least 7 days' notice is required for withdrawal.
- If someone in your household becomes afflicted with COVID-19, or thinks they may have the virus, a credit may be issued with proof of testing and students may not return until all members of household are tested and COVID-free.
- Unused tuition will be credited to your account for use until July 2021, including for the DDLL, regular classes and SSDA Summer Camps.
- If your child's school resumes to increased in-person classes, any unused, pre-paid tuition will be applied to your account as credit to be used by July 2021 for regular classes or Summer Camps at SSDA. 1 week notice is required for credit.

## Please be mindful that this is not a tutoring service.

The goal of this program is to provide a space where children can virtually learn and reduce the stress on parents to coordinate childcare. We will provide time for your child to complete their daily coursework and homework, and our staff will monitor each child to make sure that he or she is attending all of their scheduled classes on their device. However, we cannot provide teaching assistance with homework or classwork. All specific education needs should be discussed with a teacher or tutor.
